Sub:- Encouraging Independent Power Producers  
to participate in development of Mini  
Hydel Schemes in consonance with the  
policy of the Government.

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In connection with the above subject, I am directed  
to state that the State Government has been encouraging develop-  
ment of non-conventional energy resources in the State by invit-  
ing Independent Power Producers to participate in the power  
sector so that the power sector attracts more and more invest-  
ment. This policy have been evolved on the basis of the policy  
of Government of India to encourage renewable non-conventional  
energy resources and the said policy envisages that the Mini Hydel  
Projects of less than 25 MW capacity should be allotted to the  
Independent Power Producers. The experience has been that there  
is a great demand from Independent Power Producers for allotment  
of Mini Hydel Projects.

Having regard to these factors, I am to impress upon  
you that Mini Hydel Projects should be reserved for private  
sector developers and that M/s. Karnataka Power Corporation Ltd.,  
should concentrate on Mega projects of more than 25 MW capacity.
